NEED

Global Goals (SDGs) focuses on "Well-Being of All" and aims to achieve a better and sustainable future for all by 2030. Global goal -1, (SDG-1) aims to achieve 'ending poverty in all its forms everywhere.' Global goal-3 (SDG-3) aims to 'achieve a good health and well-being for all aged people.'
