Online Training on 'Integrating WASH Elements into GPDP'

(Integrating Elements of JJM and SBM-G into GPDP) (26 – 30 July, 2021)

Need

The National Jal Jeevan Mission and the SBM-G Phase-II are two flagship programmes of the Government of India. With the mandate of spending 60% of the XV Finance Commission Funds on water and sanitation components – besides spending the regular allocation states get under the SBM-G and JJM - is a great opportunity for the local bodies to prepare and implement a robust plan that can ensure sustainable water and sanitation for all. In order to fulfil this ambition, a prime requisite is that every Gram Panchayat has to prepare Gram Panchayats Development Plan (GPDP) integrating all the essential components of WASH. In doing this exercise, the challenges are many. They include (i) identifying various components of water, sanitation and hygiene in the context of a Gram Panchayat; (ii) prioritizing to be able to have a perspective plan, and annual action plans; and (iii) looking into the programme convergence possibilities so as to access the sources of funds for implementation etc. This training programme aims at providing the technicalities, and the guidance required to be able to integrate WASH elements into GPDP. The clientele groups targeted are officials working in the District and Block level Water and Sanitation Mission. The officers working in RWSS Department, PHED and at RD&PR Department in charge water, sanitation and MGNREGS.

Objectives

- To introduce the GPDP Framework and the components of WASH covered in the Jal Jeevan Mission, and SBM-G Phase – II
- To refresh on the implications of XV FC recommendations on water, sanitation, hygiene and health within the institutional framework of PRIs
- To demonstrate ways to prepare a comprehensive GPDP focusing on WASH components, and scheme convergence possibilities.
- To discuss ways to motivate the Gram Panchayats to prepare quality GPDP with proper perspective plan and annual plan encompassing all WASH components.

The training is for the district and block level coordinators, working for Rural Water Supply Department, RD&PR, PHEDs who have the responsibility of training grassroots level facilitators, or guide the Gram Panchayats or local teams that are involved in preparing GPDP / Village Action Plan / Swachhata Action Plan for water and sanitation services. The participants can draw ideas from this course to customise them to the context of one's own state. This programme is being designed bearing in view the concepts and functional strategies of JJM and SBM-G. Thus, some local NGOs working as Institutional Support Agencies (ISAs) / KRCs of Jal Jeevan Mission (JJM) are also invited to register.
