**EMPANELMENT OF CONSULTANT ENGINEERS**

**1. Introduction:**

The Ministry of Rural Development (MoRD), GoI implements a number of schemes for rural development. The training programmes for these schemes are organized at

(i) National Institute of Rural Development & Panchayat Raj (NIRDPR) (ii) State Institutes of Rural Development (SIRDs) and Extension Training Centres (ETCs).

The main objective of training programmes is to competencies of various Rural Development functionaries and elected representatives of Panchayati Raj Institutions (PRIs) at National, State, District, Block and Sub-Block levels and to strengthen and assist the various training institutes so as to enable them to carry out their mandate in an effective and efficient manner. The SIRDs are the state level institutions while the Extension Training Centers (ETCs) are the sub-State/Block level institutions. At present there are 29 SIRDs and 90 ETCs which are functioning in different parts of the country.

The MoRD has initiated central scheme for strengthening of SIRDs and ETCs under which funding support is provided to the institutions for Non-Recurring expenditure for strengthening of physical infrastructure (renovation / repairs of existing buildings and new constructions), Teaching-aids and Office equipment and furniture / furnishing etc.

## 2. The Strategy for Submission and Scrutiny of the Non-Recurring Grant proposals

The MoRD in the beginning of the financial year issues a circular letter to all State Governments, SIRDs and ETCs with a request to submit the proposals – both Non-recurring & Recurring (GOI's share), in the prescribed proformae.

According to the guidelines, the respective SIRDs & ETCs have to route their proposals – both Recurring and Non-Recurring, through the State Government. The Non-Recurring Grant proposals seeking funding support for Physical infrastructure, Teaching Aids and Office Equipment/Furniture etc. submitted to facilitate examining each proposal and offer comments to MoRD for final sanction.

Under the existing guidelines for seeking funding support under Non-Recurring for Physical Infrastructure (for **Civil works** – new constructions and major repairs/renovation), the proposals from SIRDs / ETCs need to accompany the following documents:

- i. **Cost estimates** should be approved by the PWD or other Engg. Dept. of the State Government concerned and to be certified (with stamp) by the officer not below the rank of Executive Engineer of the concerned agency.
- ii. **Site-map** duly approved by PWD or Engg. Depts. Not below the rank of Executive Engineer with seal.
- iii. **The item-wise detailed** cost of construction / renovation of building is also to be furnished.

In accordance with the suggestion made by MoRD that NIRDPR's recommendations on the proposals need to be based on 'field situation' coupled with 'technical scrutiny' of the civil works and its estimates by the Engineering staff. Hence, it is proposed to empanel the retired Engineers from State / Central PWD, to make use of their services, on case-to-case basis.

### **3. Method of Scrutiny of the Proposals**

Each proposal of SIRD/ ETC will be subjected to thorough check including technical scrutiny by the engineering staff, in addition to having an explicit visit to the site. This would enable to have detailed interaction with the respective SIRD / ETC, to inspect the works on site and to have interaction with State counterparts.

For this purpose, it is envisaged that a panel of Consultant Engineers retired from State or Central PWD will be prepared and the Consultant Engineers from the approved panel will be deputed, as required, to the respective SIRD/ ETC in different States by NIRDPR to inspect the site, have interaction with local officers and examine the proposal including technical scrutiny of the estimates of the civil / electrical works and submit a detailed report covering all aspects.

### **4. Remuneration**

The consolidated remuneration of Rs.10,000/- paid for every site visit. Since the job entitles the travel of the Consultant Engineer to the respective SIRD / ETC, he will be paid (to & fro) by economy class airfares. The local transport and stay arrangement of the Consultant Engineer while on tour will be arranged by NIRDPR through respective SIRD / ETC. The Consultant Engineer (s) will work under the overall guidance and control of Assistant Professor (CRTCN), Training Division, NIRDPR.

### **5. Format of Application**

The format of application for submission of candidature by the interested persons is placed at Annexure and the same may be sent by post to Assistant Registrar (E), National Institute of Rural Development & Panchayati Raj, Rajendranagar, Hyderabad-500030 or through mail at [training.nird@gov.in](mailto:training.nird@gov.in) , on or before **15<sup>th</sup> July, 2019**.
