Background

Achieving universal health coverage by 2030 is the overarching target of the Sustainable Development Goals. The National Health Policy 2017 too echoed it. Govt of India launched in 2018, Ayushman Bharat program translating the policy intent into budgetary commitment. About 1,50,000 Ayushman Bharat Health and Wellness Centers (AB_HWCs) are being established by upgrading the existing sub health centers and primary health centers in rural and urban areas. The AB_HWCs are envisaged to deliver comprehensive primary health care services inclusive of promotive, preventive and curative, rehabilitative, palliative care to all people closer to their homes. This ambitious goal can only be realized with active participation and engagement of the community.

Involvement of Panchayati Raj Institutions is hence crucial to ensure action on social, cultural and environmental determinants of health and for effective community-based monitoring, as these elected representatives are Presidents of Jan Arogya Samitis and Village Health, Sanitation and Nutrition Committees (VHSNCs) – the community based multistakeholder platform. The health grants to PRIs and ULBs by XV Finance Commission and localization of SDG initiative by the Ministry of Panchayat Raj have added fillip to the role of PRIs/ULBs in health care planning, delivery, and monitoring.

Thus , the members of the Panchayati Raj Institutions need appropriate orientation and capacity to effectively perform their role in this regard.

In view of the above the National Institute of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj (NIRDPR) in collaboration with National Health Systems Resource Centre, New Delhi the technical assistance body of MoHFW is organizing National level ToTs programs for capacity building of PRIs on Health towards creating a pool of National level Trainers who would indulge in training the elected members on a cascade mode on the following date.

Duration

14th to 17th March 2023 (04 days)

Objective

- To create a pool of National Level Master Trainers to train the Elected Members of PRIs and SHGs on a Cascade Mode
- Capacity Building of Panchayati Raj Functionaries on Health for better community Health Care.

Who can participate?

Master Trainers from SIRD, Rural Development & Panchayati Raj Department, SRLM and NRLM, Trainers from reputed NGOs and CSOs working on Public Health, Master Certified Resource Persons of PRIs working on Health and Freelancers working in the area of Health and Development.

Nominations are invited from those who are conversant in English and Hindi and have the caliber to deliver the trainings at the National Level.

Number of Seats: 40

As there are limited number of seats, selection will be done based on the broad objectives of the programme.
